Working class families with a common bond of raising families and having neighborhood block parties has changed to living amongst people who stay to themselves, don't speak English, and don't care about others.

We live a few blocks from 280 surrounded by horribly unpaved streets (Crestview Dr. is the worst street in Millbrae). We live near 280. We have no parks for children to play at and no neighborhood school anymore.

No bus line in my area public schools have deteriorated, closed the school in our neighborhood, no parks. Thank God we still have our great fire station. We don't have a police department and sadly the safety in our neighborhoods + downtown is severely lacking.

Teens burned down our rec. center and never held responsible our rec activities are not entertaining or interesting, the new religion in our area is "Covid". Everyone is a Believer.
